Thank you for participating in the carboNZero project, and congratulations on receiving the carboNZero certificate. This confirms that you are regularly measuring, managing and mitigating emissions from your organisations activities.

The EBEX21 carbon credits purchased by your organisation are generated via the restoration of indigenous forests in New Zealand. These act as carbon sinks, as the growing trees store atmospheric carbon dioxide (CO₂) as carbon in the wood. EBEX21 scientifically verifies how many credits are available to sell on each restoration site.

By investing in the restoration of indigenous forests, your organisation is not only offsetting CO₂ emissions, but also helping to protect New Zealand's fragile and unique biodiversity, reduce soil erosion problems, and enhance catchment water quality.
